Master a variety of teaching techniques to help students learn the curriculum as effectively as possible, using a variety of teaching methods, teaching techniques, and the expertise of master choreographers.

Have the ability to teach European and Latin American programs for performers of classes E and D, contributing to the development of theoretical foundations and practical application of these dance disciplines; teach performers the basics and subtleties of basic dance figures and connections, using the theory and methodology of teaching ballroom dancing sports; to develop and improve students' creativity combined with profound knowledge of theoretical and practical foundations in composing competitive compositions of Tango, Slow Waltz, Vienna Waltz, Quickstep, Rumba, Samba, Cha-cha-cha and Jive dances; apply psychological-pedagogical and methodological bases of scientific theory and artistic practice, combine traditional and innovative approaches to the learning process; be able to manage the cognitive processes of students, consistently and methodologically competent to form mental, emotional and motor actions at a high pedagogical level.

PC<sub>F</sub>. know ballet terminology and basics of classical and folk and stage dance; be able to develop and apply in practice program sets of exercises for the 2nd and 3rd years of training in classical and folk and stage dance in educational institutions (exertion at the bar and in the middle of the hall), to make special sets of exercises to develop physical fitness and professional qualities in classical and folk and stage dance, to teach choreography; be able to independently search, process, analyze and evaluate professional information, acquire new knowledge in the field of classical and folk dance, using modern educational and information technology; be personally responsible for their effective implementation.

PC<sub>G</sub>-know the theory, terminology and methodology of teaching the figures by levels of difficulty and make competitive compositions of Latin American and European dances (C class) such as "Samba", "Rumba", "Cha-cha-cha", "Jive"; "Tango", "Slow Waltz", "Vienna Waltz", "Quickstep", Carry out pedagogical and rehearsal work on these types of dances, know the basic approaches in individual-oriented strategies for teaching performers, generalize, analyze incoming information, set tasks for performers and help them achieve them; be able to explain and show methodologically complex figures and combinations of movements, be familiar with the age features of students, have psychological and pedagogical methods of work with performers, and apply these skills in their practical work.

PC<sub>H</sub> be able to compose ballroom sport dance (European and Latin American) compositions of varying difficulty levels, selecting music and figure combinations (including figures for E and D classes); be able to organize a complete educational and training process to study Latin and European dances with modern technology and teaching developments; apply own practical experience in teaching students to master programs; know the conceptual apparatus in the field of methodology and technology of mastering the practical material, to be able to find approaches to

students, owning the psychological and pedagogical skills, and encourage performers to display artistic creativity; know the rules of judging sports ballroom dancing, ethics of behavior of judges at competitions, to be able to objectively evaluate the performances of performers.

PC<sub>I</sub>- Have the skills to develop and conduct lessons in folk, Kazakh and oriental dance; specifics of women's and men's parts; be able to develop and apply in practice program sets of exercises for the 3rd year of folk dance in educational institutions (exertion at the bar and in the middle of the hall); make special sets of exercises to develop physical form and professional qualities in folk dance; have the basics of national choreography of the world's dances, be able to analyze and downplay: be able to independently search, process, analyze and evaluate information of folk, Kazakh and oriental dance, have the ability not only to effectively teach, but also to generate new ideas in this direction; possess the practical skills of performing jazz dance, composing combinations and etudes;

PC<sub>J</sub> - have knowledge of the 4th year program of classical dance and its program movements (exersis at the barre and in the middle of the hall) in vocational schools; know modern methods and technologies and be able to teach choreography and ballet gymnastics, have the basics of composing choreography lessons; use knowledge of human anatomy and biomechanics of movements in dance, age and physiological features of the human body, including understanding the form and structure of organs, and apply this knowledge in theory and in training; Have knowledge of historical and everyday dances: their choreographic features and uniqueness, various physical aspects of dance and understanding of their performance principles, be able to experiment and improvise within this knowledge, applying creative approaches and variation in the learning process; know the history of costume and orient in different eras and styles.
